Tickets: All vehicles and passengers must have a valid ticket prior to travel.

Book your ticket online, in advance of travel, even if you're a foot passenger, at calmac.co.uk

Vehicle drivers and their passengers must be available for boarding no later than 20 minutes prior to departure, otherwise travel cannot be guaranteed.

Foot passengers: must be available for boarding no later than 20 minutes before departure and have your ticket ready to be scanned.

Light goods vehicles (LGVs): LGVs exceeding 6 metres in length or 3.5 tonnes in weight, or 3 metres in height, or 2.3 metres in width are charged at commercial vehicle rate.
