Please read the notes in the table below for the relevant information you need to know about this route, prior to travel.

Tickets: All vehicles and passengers must have a valid ticket prior to travel. Book your ticket online, in advance of travel, even if you're a foot passenger at calmac.co.uk

Vehicle drivers and their passengers must be available for boarding no later than 30 minutes prior to departure, otherwise travel cannot be guaranteed. Follow signs to the car lanes at the port and have your ticket ready to be scanned.

Foot passengers must be available for boarding no later than 30 minutes before departure, where your ticket will be scanned before boarding the ferry.

Amended timetables:

23 and 30 May: An amended timetable will operate on 23 and 30 May for Fèis Ìle.

9, 13, 14 July: All sailings on this route will be cancelled on Thursday 9 July and an amended timetable will operate on 13 and 14 July due to the Tìre Music Festival.

17 September: An amended timetable will operate on 17 September for Ceòl Cholasa.

Early departure during inclement weather: During inclement weather, the vessel may depart from Colonsay earlier than the published timetable. Passengers and vehicles must be available for boarding on arrival of the vessel into Colonsay.

Increased stopover time: Limited increased stopover time for the delivery of goods can be requested by the community. This is at the Master's discretion - and is weather permitting. Contact the Oban or Colonsay port office for more information.

Train times displayed are valid from 16 May 2026. Always check scotrail.co.uk for the latest info before travel.

Commercial vehicle bookings are handled at individual ports. For this route, contact Oban port office on 01631 700506 and select option 2 on a touch-tone phone.

Travelling with a Caravan or Motorhome: Motorhomes and Caravans may be permitted in Colonsay but only by contacting Colonsay Estate on 01951 200211 prior to travel.

Light goods vehicles (LGVs): LGVs exceeding 6 metres in length or 3.5 tonnes in weight, or 3 metres in height, or 2.3 metres in width are charged at commercial vehicle rate.
