Vehicle drivers and their passengers must be available for boarding no later than 30 minutes prior to departure, otherwise travel cannot be guaranteed. Follow signs to the car lanes at the port and have your ticket ready to be scanned.
Foot passengers must be available for boarding no later than 10 minutes before departure, where your ticket will be scanned before boarding the ferry.
