A: Tuesdays to Saturday morning only train connections. Change at Fort William. Reservations are compulsory from Fort William. Please note there is no connection on Saturday night from Fort William to Glasgow.

Tickets: All vehicles and passengers must have a valid ticket prior to travel. Book your ticket online, in advance of travel, even if you're a foot passenger at calmac.co.uk.
Vehicle drivers and their passengers must be available for boarding no later than 20 minutes prior to departure, otherwise travel cannot be guaranteed. Follow signs to the car lanes at the port and have your ticket ready to be scanned.

Foot passengers: must be available for boarding no later than 10 minutes before departure, where your ticket will be scanned before boarding the ferry.

Trains times displayed are valid until 16 May 2026. **Train connections** are not guaranteed as some trains arrive/depart with less than the necessary time to travel between the ferry terminal and train station. Please always check www.scotrail.co.uk for the latest info before travel.
