Vehicles and passengers must be available for boarding no later than 10 minutes before departure and have your ticket ready to be scanned.

Commercial vehicle bookings are handled at individual ports. For this route, please contact Kennacraig on 01880 280281 and select option 2 on a touch-tone phone.

Caravans are not permitted in Gigha. No caravan site facilities are available.

Onward travel: The bus stop in Tayinloan village is approximately half a mile from the ferry terminal. A local taxi service is available to transfer between the bus and the ferry in both directions. This is bookable in advance and payable at the time of travel. To book a taxi contact McDonald Mini Coaches on 07799 845464.

Light goods vehicles (LGVs): LGVs exceeding 6 metres in length or 3.5 tonnes in weight, or 3 metres in height, or 2.3 metres in width are charged at commercial vehicle rate.
